

A Halloween Tale



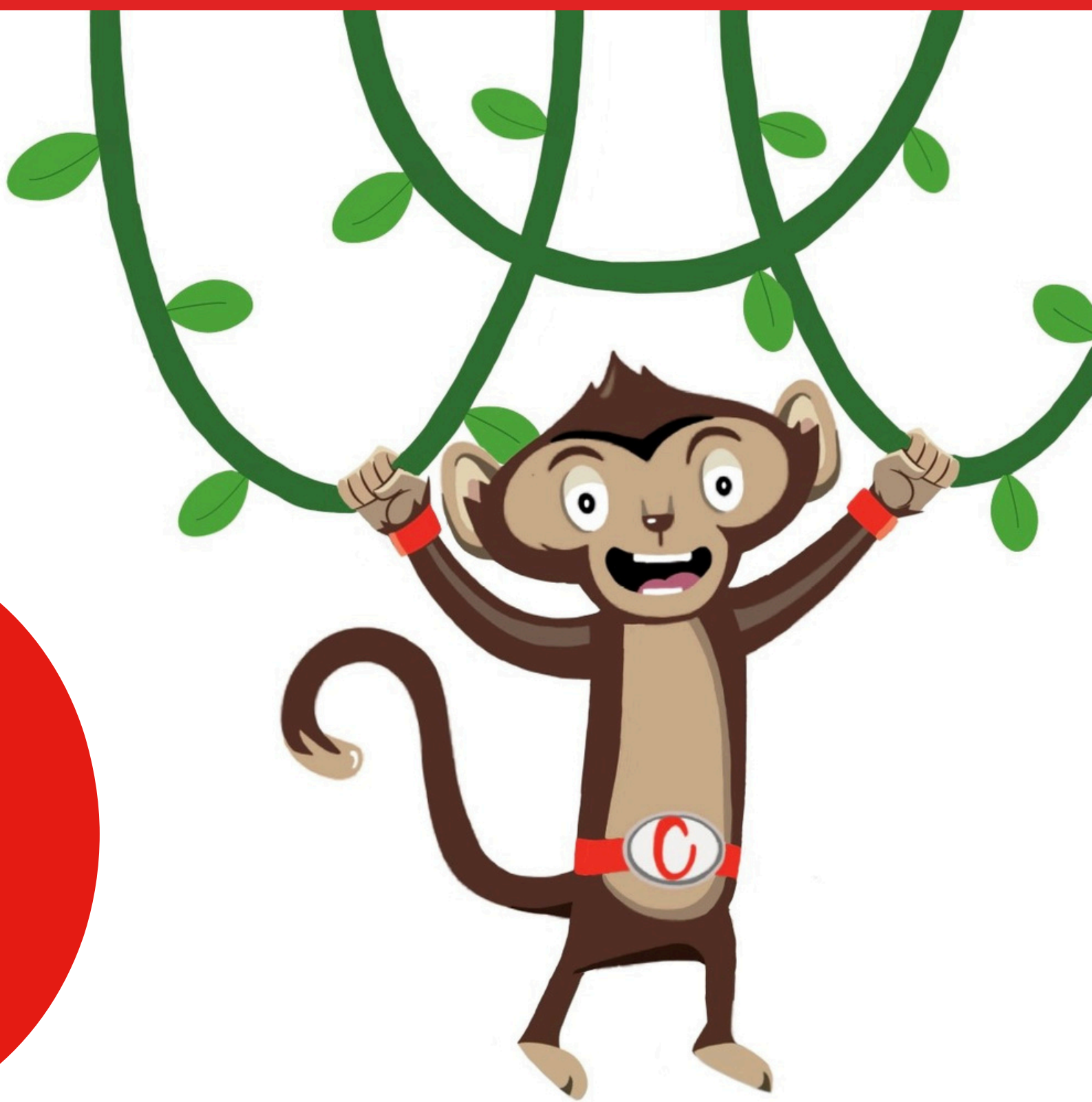
Lively Lesson

5+ dice



Instructions

Divide the class into small groups and give each group a dice. The dice is used to set the scene of the short story which the group will act out in front of the class. 1st throw = story setting, 2nd throw = characters and the 3rd throw = storyline. Give the class a few minutes to decide on their stories and then let them practice for a few minutes before acting out their story.

Health & Safety

- Ensure floors are clear of trip hazards
- Remind pupils of their own spatial awareness
- Give clear instructions



Teacher Tips

This activity is best suited to KS1 & KS2 but can be made suitable for Foundation. See activity sheet for examples.

Foundation: This activity could be carried out as a whole class and they create an active story led by the teacher and the pupils follow along.
