Instructions

Teacher divides the class into groups of 3-5 pupils where they act out a movie, book, song or make it relate to the curriculum. At the start the pupils can indicate whether it's a book, by pretending to open a book. If it's a song, they pretend to sign into a microphone. If it's a movie, they can draw a square with both hands indicating a TV.

Health & Safety



The pupils could pretend to be various animals such as,


- Elephant
