Monkey Madness



5 minutes



Ask pupils to stand, and choose a word and draw a dashed line on the board with how many letters there are in that word. Ask the class to take turns at guessing letters. If the letter

guessed is in the word, write it on the dashed line in the place it belongs. However, if a letter is guessed and it is not in the word, a spider's body can be drawn on the board and a list of letters not belonging in the word as a reminder. After each incorrect letter is guessed, draw a spider leg on the body, and the game is over when the spider has 8 legs, or when the word has been guessed.

Health & Safety

- Ensure floors are clear of trip hazards before taking part in any activity.
- Ensure pupils leave stationary on the table.
- Remind pupils of their own spatial awareness.
- Give clear instructions.
