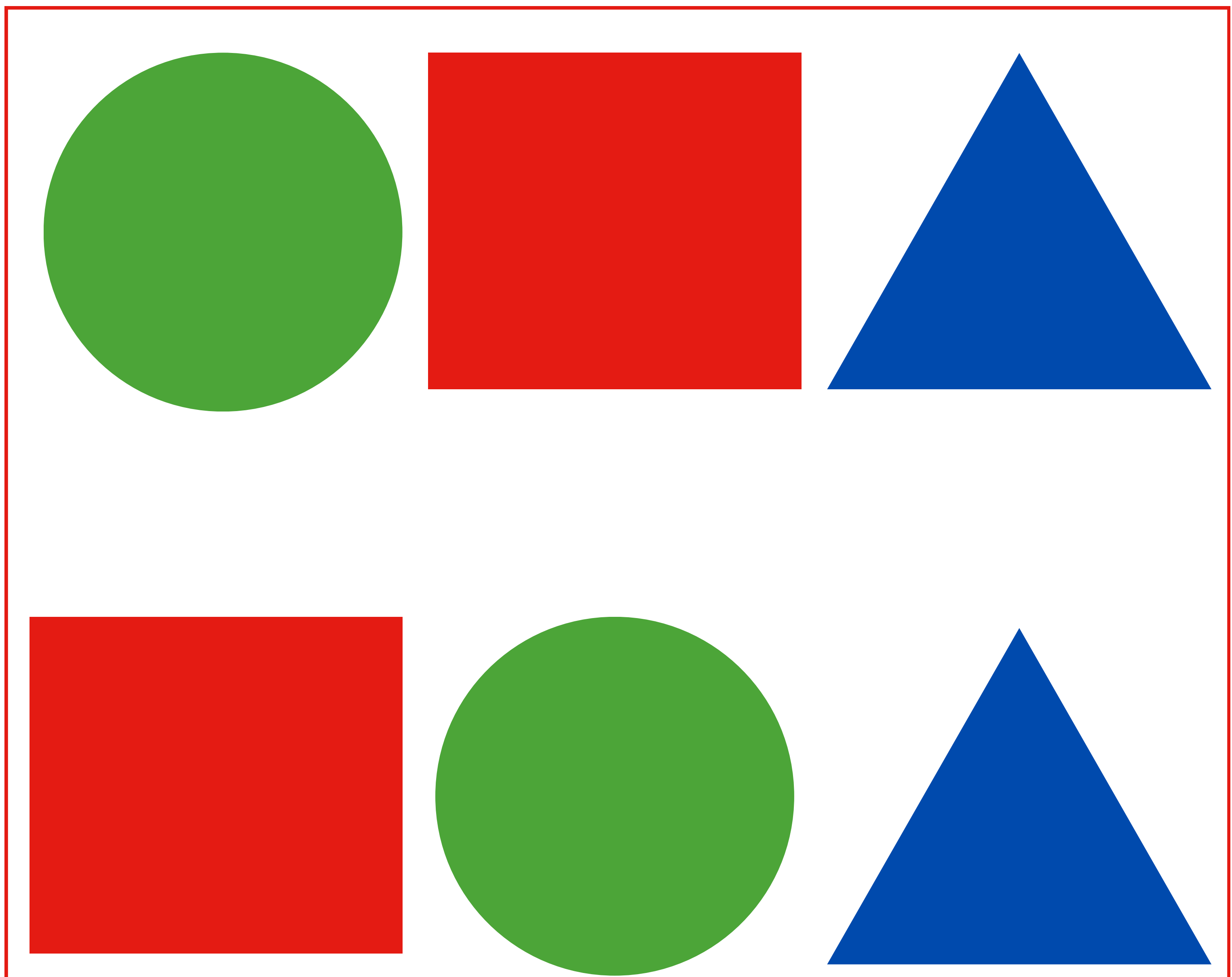


Match Activity

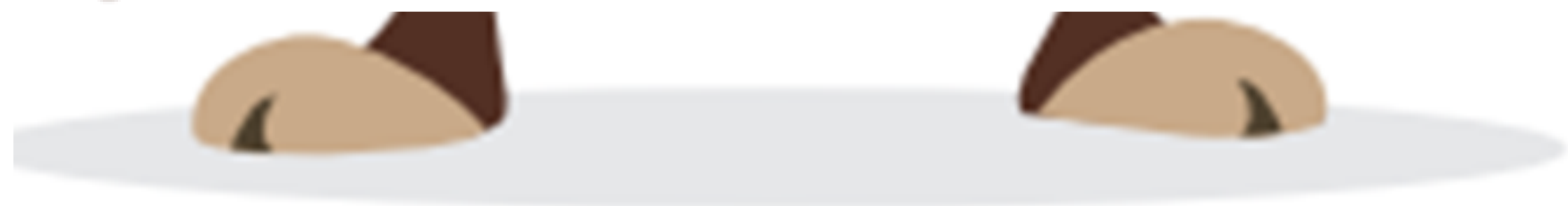

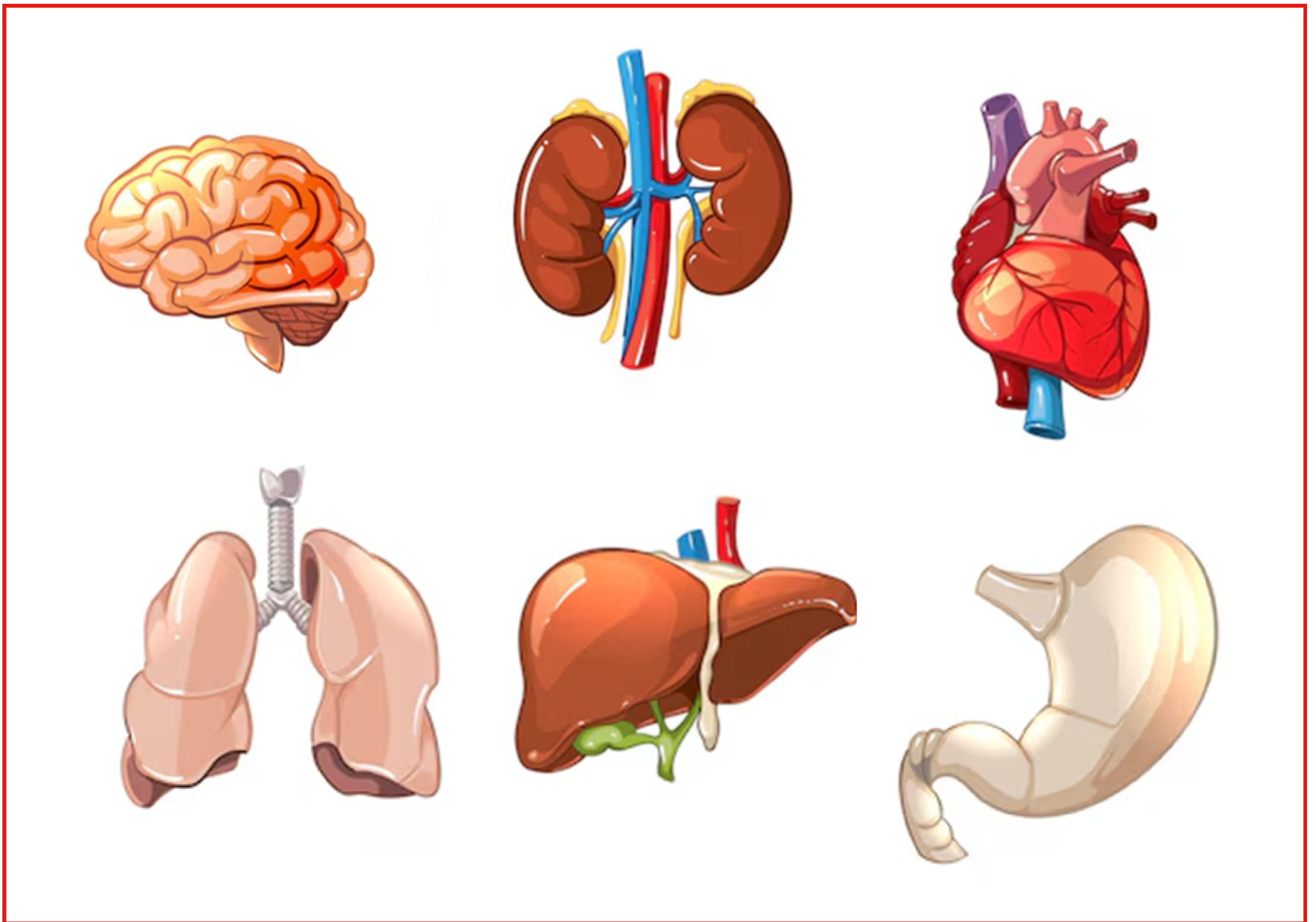

Key Stage 2 Examples:



Brain: controls our body by sending messages to all the different parts of our body

Kidneys: a small organ that filters out waste products from our blood

Stomach: is an organ that breaks down food into smaller pieces

Heart: one of the most important organs that pumps blood around out whole body

Lungs: breathe in fresh air and transport oxygen into our blood

Liver: can break down food and turn it into energy
